Dear Prayer Partners:

Grace be unto you and peace from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be God even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort.

Things are going great in Nochistlan. We still have a few things to do on the house but they can wait. We have started knocking on doors and telling people about our Savior. The people are real receptive to the Word of God. We have had a couple of professions of faith. We have some names of some people who said they wanted a Bible Study. Luis, the young man I am training for the ministry, moved over to Nochistlan with us. He preached his first sermon in Jalpa. He did a great job. He preached for 38 minutes. He is going to make a great pastor. We just need to find him a good wife.

Here are our plans for the coming year. We would ask you to join with us in prayer as we work for our Lord and Savior in 2012. We will be starting a Wednesday night Bible Study in our Home in January. We have two Bible studies lined up in homes. We plan to visit the ranches in the area and start a kids club. Gladys, the sister of Luis, will be moving to Nochistlan to help us with the children. She is a missionary to children and wants to come and work with us for a while. She has been part of our VBS team for the last four years. She was sent out by the church in Jalpa and is a graduate from the Bible College in Jalpa. I will be teaching two classes on Tuesday in the Bible Institute and one Friday nights. We will be driving over to Jalpa and going to church there on Sundays until we get enough people to start a church here.

We have been working on three different projects in December that we had projected for last year. We got the floor poured in the Sunday School Class Room in Tabasco. We built a pulpit area for the church in Jalpa and we are in the process of building a baptismal pool in Jalpa. I am real proud of how the people come together to work no matter which church we are working in. We usually have to much help.

The Family Camp was a real success. We had eighty-two people present. We were expecting a lot more but only four churches showed up, the Church in Tabasco, the Church in Jalpa, the Church in Calvillo and one Church from Aguascalientes. They want to do it again next year so I am working on it.

Cindy and I have been having some health issues. Cindy has been having trouble with her good thumb but she does not want to have surgery on it. She says the thumb she had surgery on is worse than the good thumb. Her neck has been bothering her again. Since we moved to Nochistlan my blood sugar and blood pressure has going crazy. Christmas Day we did not make it to church I was at the hospital for over two hours. I did not know a doctor in town but now I think I know them all. They had a lot of theories of what was wrong but they finally decided my body had grown immune to the medicine and they changed my medicine. Both of these diseases attack the organs of your body and my last visit my heart and kidneys were almost back down to normal. The doctor said with the new medicine I should be back to normal in four to six weeks. I am on one pill for my heart, one for sugar and two for high blood pressure. I got a letter from the Veterans Administration from all the tests I took while I was on furlough and they gave me 10% disability for the Agent Orange.
