I have never ever been a person who enjoys asking for anything. I would consider myself very independent and my range of dependance very small. For example, as a fourteen year old boy I wanted to go places and do things but I didn't want to ask my parents for the money, so I got a job and earned my own money. While others played sports though junior high and high school, I worked after school, bought my own car, paid my own insurance, and did my own things. When God put me in BPS, that mindset changed. I found myself in a position that demanded support for our family, so I had to ask. We needed money to buy paper, so I had to ask, and if I desire the ministry to grow past my tenure, then I must alter my plans and train others. I believe that the publishing of God's Word is not only exemplified in the Bible, but is also a command by God for God's people. Therefore, I must ask for help and I must train others.

Last year about this time, a young man, named Aaron, came from Mt. Zion BC in PA to train at BPS. He just finished his first year at our Bible College (Biblical School of World Evangelism) and has been working in our shop learning the ropes. About a month ago another young man from the same church came to volunteer his summer at BPS in exchange to gain ministry experience. He will be trained for a few months and then return home. On August the 2nd, a family from Augusta, GA will be moving to Milford to join our team. We will have the opportunity to train them over the next two years.

As God has entrusted us with a growing ministry, not only do we need physical help, but we also need financial help. Only as God sends the funds in, the Scriptures are able to go out. Through our Seedline churches, we just completed a project of 750,000 Bulgarian John/Romans. Half of those were shipped out June 29th and the other half will ship out soon. We also finished up a project going to Burkina Faso of 300,000 John/Romans. I have been working on a container going to the Congo for about two years and it is soon to be on its way. The shop is binding French whole Bibles and will print and bind English whole Bibles within the next few weeks for that container. Also, the Sranan Tongo whole Bibles will all be bound soon for Suriname. All this and more is happening at BPS because God is working through His people. Recently, we were presented with the opportunity to print a container of whole Bibles for the Philippines. This will consist of about 35,000 Bibles which means it will cost about \$35,000. As I stated earlier, I hate to ask, but I believe God wants these people to have His Word in print. It is my privilege and my responsibility to speak to you for the Filipino people and to ask you to help with this great need. Would you at least ask God how He would want you to respond to this need?

On the 4th of July, Vickie and I celebrated our 24th wedding anniversary and also July marks our 11th year in BPS. We praise the Lord for what He has done in our lives. He has given us three great children, a place to serve, and many friends just like you, all over the world.

Aaron, our youngest son, graduated from high school this past May and is praying about his next step in life.
